Marist Hockey Club expects all our coaches, parents and players to follow the relevant Codes of Conduct. For our young players under 12, parents please explain the codes to your children and sign on their behalf.

Code of Conduct:

1. Play by the rules.
2. Never argue with an official. If you disagree have your captain, coach or manager talk to the official during a break or after the match.
3. Control your temper. Verbal abuse of officials or other players, deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent is not acceptable or permitted in any sport.
4. Work equally hard for yourself and your team. Your team's performance will benefit; so will you.
5. Be a good sport. Applaud all good plays whether by your team or an opponent.
6. Treat all players as you would like to be treated. Do not interfere with, bully or take unfair advantage of another player.
7. Co-operate with your coach, team-mates and opponents. Without them there would be no competition.
8. Display modesty in victory and graciousness in defeat.
9. Play for your enjoyment and benefit, not just to please parents and coaches.
10. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all other players regardless of their ability or cultural background.
11. Thank the opposition and officials at the end of the game.
